For example, you can set up a weather app tile to show more data about where you're interested, or see more daily schedules displayed on the Calendar app tile. If you're also using desktop apps on a tablet or hybrid device, you can make shortcuts very small so you don't confuse them with the tiles you use in the latest apps. You can also use smaller tiles to add more tiles to the Start screen. The process of adding, grouping, and naming new tiles and shortcuts has also been improved. In Windows 8.1, it's much easier to pin shortcuts to Start. For example, in Windows 8, it was impossible to pin your PC settings to Start without using a strange solution. In Windows 8.1 this is done with a few tabs. Finally, there are more ways to organize the appearance of the Start screen. There are more wallpapers, backgrounds and accent colors to choose from. You can also set up a Start screen to use custom wallpapers that are the same as desktops. 2. New and useful touch apps Windows 8.1 also introduces many new touch apps: alarm, calculator, sound recorder, food and beverage, health and fitness, reading list and scan. As you can see, they are very diverse in what they do, but one thing they have in common, it's very useful for them. They all work well in what they do and high quality apps that can be useful to most tablet users. 6. Search is faster and better for me, this is one of the biggest new features in Windows 8.1 – search and integration with Bing and other services. Not only can you perform a faster search in Windows 8.1, but the results are displayed in a beautiful way. This includes local files, shortcuts and apps, as well as information from web and services such as Xbox Music, Wikipedia, Freebase, Windows Store, and Bing. Lock your tablet (don't sign in) and place your finger on the lock screen at the top of the screen and drag it downwards. The camera app opens and can be used to record quick photos or recording videos without having to sign in to Windows 8.1. If you have a front camera, you can also switch between cameras at the touch of a button. 10. Easy to get help when meeting Windows 8.1 for the first time microsoft did not provide much in terms of help for new users to learn the shortcomings of the new interface. Fortunately, Windows 8.1 solved this problem by providing a new app called Help+Tips. You can use it to quickly learn the basics of the Start screen, built-in apps, basic tasks for exploring the operating system, custom settings, and more. Bottom line I hope you can agree with me when I touch and say all these improvements add to the more productive experience when using Windows 8.1 on the device. My list is not comprehensive in any way. With so many small improvements, microsoft is difficult to notice and document everything.
